Locating The Hartford's Preferred Providers and Pharmacies

Mileage Search (If you would like to use your location address and choose the type of providers for your directory)

- 1. You can then enter the address of the location. You do not need to insert a name or full address. Results obtained by using city and state, or zip code. Limiting your search using city, results will be providers and locations within the radius from the center of that city. When entering a specific street, city and state the results will be listed in proximity of the address. Listing city, state or zip code only will limit your search and will not be specific to the particular location. Providers will be listed in proximity to the center of that city or town if you don't have the exact address or zip.
- 2. Choose a mileage radius, for best results you may want to select 30 miles.
- 3. To increase the number of providers that will be shown on a page, increase the *Providers/Per Page*.
- 4. Select Provider Type- You can choose a specific specialty or multiple specialties by clicking the box to right of the desired provider group. Then click Find Providersor
- 5. Directly below, click on Search by Specialty.

Quick Search (This is the most convenient way to locate initial treating providers and also Express Scripts Pharmacies)

- 1. If you are looking to obtain an initial listing of providers and pharmacies that the employee may use at the time they report the injury, you can do so by clicking on the *Quick Search Tab* at the bottom of the page
- 2. You will need to provide an address and/or city, state and/or zip.
- 3. Then click Find Providers

Name Search (If you have a provider and you would like to see if they are part of the network)

- 1. You may search on a provider's last name OR the clinic/provider group name
- 2. You must supply the state they are located.
- 3. The less detail you give in the name, the more search results you will receive.
- 4. This is not always the best method to find a provider, if you have the providers city/state, we recommend doing a complete listing to see if they are included.
- 5. Then click Find Providers.
